U14 girls - 60 m, 300 m (**normative 52.00**), 1000 m, 60 m/b (12.00 - 7.50 – 68,6), high jump, long jump, shot put (2 kg)

U14 boys - 60 m, 300 m (**normative 51.00**), 1000 m, 60 m/b (13.0 - 7.50 - 76.2), high jump, long jump, shot put (3 kg)

U16 girls - 60 m, 300 m (**normative 50.00**), 1000 m, 60 m/b (12.00 - 8.00 - 76.2), high jump, long jump, shot put (3 kg)

U16 boys - 60 m, 300 m (**normative 47.00**), 1000 m, 60 m/b (13.00 - 8.50 - 83.8), high jump, long jump, shot put (4 kg)

U18 young women – 60 m, 200 m, 600 m, 1500 m, 60 m/b (13.00 – 8,50 – 76,2), high jump, long jump, shot put (3 kg)

U18 young people – 60 m, 200 m, 600 m, 1500 m, 60 m/b (13.72 – 9.14 – 91.4), high jump, long jump, shot put (5 kg)

U20 juniors (W) – 60 m, 200 m, 600 m, 1500 m, 60 m/b (13.00 – 8.50 – 83.8), high jump, long jump, shot put (4 kg)

U20 juniors (M) – 60 m, 200 m, 600 m, 1500 m, 60 m/b (13.72 – 9.14 – 99.1), high jump, long jump, shot put (6 kg)

REGULATIONS

Winners are determined according to World Athletics competition rules.

It is **prohibited** to participate in Latvian and Estonian national team forms.

The competition number issued to the participant must be securely attached (in four corners), the number must not have cropped or folded edges.

AWARDING

In each discipline, 1-3 winners are awarded medals. **News! The travelling trophy donated by the association *Valmiera NEXT* will be contested in the U18 and U20 team competition (03.01.2026). The 15 highest-value results according to World Athletics points will be evaluated (60 m hurdles and shot-put results will be adjusted to adults standards).**

ATHLETE APPLICATIONS

All expenses related to participation of participants in competitions shall be covered by the commanding organisation. Participation fee in the competition **EUR 8,00** per participant. The costs of organising the competition are covered by Valmiera Sports School, Valmiera Athletics Club and Maret-Sport.

The application for competition on the website of LVS shall be www.athletics.lv until 29 December 2025 at 12:00. Athletes or organisations that do not have access to the LVS statistical system shall send their applications to the Secretary of the Competition by e-mail in sacensibas@valmiera.edu.lv marked "Valmiera-Valga". The application must state the name, birth data, the organisation represented, the result and the discipline.

Athletes from Valmiera Sports School and sports club Maret-Sport have been exempted from membership fees.

Sports clubs and sports schools shall, no later than 2 hours before the start of the competition, withdraw participants who will not participate in the competition by sending SMS to telephone No.: 29830197 (Austra Ķikāne) indicating: the name, gender, age group and discipline of the athlete.

Travel, accommodation and catering expenses of participants shall be covered by the commanding organisation or the participant himself or herself.

Other conditions

Only replacement shoes may be used in the indoor facility.

The participants application confirms that athletes can be photographed during the competition and photos taken by organisers can be used for posting on social networks. The organisation applying for the participants or the participant itself shall be responsible for the compliance of the participant's health with the competition.
