Competitions will be conducted in accordance with the IAAF Competition Rules, Anti-Doping Rules and competition regulations approved by the organizers on the territory of each state.

Composition and Structure of Participating Teams

Teams Composition: 24 athletes, 8 officials.

Teams Structure: **32 people in total, including 24 athletes and 7 officials and a judge who will be involved in judging.**

Each team may enter 1 athlete in each event competition program with the exception of relay (1 mixed team in the relay).

Determination of Winners

Winners of the competitions are determined separately by the events of the competition program, as well as in the team competition.

Scoring in team competitions is carried out according to the Competition Regulations.

Financing Costs & Conditions of Travel & Accommodation Expenses

Each team shall pay the cost of international travel expenses to / from Minsk, entry visas (in case of late filing, visa fee is required), medical insurance.

Competition organizers will cover the local transportation expenses to / from airport / railway station to / from the hotel/stadium to a place of competition / training, sports facilities, etc.

The organizers of the competitions will provide accommodation and full board for participating teams in the period from 23.02.2018 to 26.02.2018.

Arrival and departure should be in accordance with the regulations of the competition.

Procedure and Deadlines for Submitting Applications for Participation in Competitions

Preliminary applications specifying the number of participants and details of arrival must be submitted by email: belarus.athletics@gmail.com up to January 24, 2017.

Final Entries **specifying the number of participants** by events must **be submitted** until February 14, 2018.

Final Confirmations are submitted with the first and last names of the athletes, the events of the competition program and the first and last names of the coaches no later than the day of arrival at the competitions venue and within the time specified by the organizers of the competition.

This Contract shall enter into force on the date of its signing by the authorized representatives.
