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INTRODUCTION

1. INTRODUCTION

This guide has been prepared by the Accreditation team at Paris 2024 to provide details of the personal information required for each accreditation applicant, including the data formats, identity document requirements and photograph specifications.

Responsible Organisations, as identified by the International Olympic Committee (IOC), International Paralympic Committee (IPC), or Paris 2024, must submit their accreditation applications electronically through the Paris 2024 Games Management System (GMS).

This document outlines the necessary data that Responsible Organisations are required to collect for the applications of members of their delegation or workforce who may require accreditation for the Games.

Applications for accreditation should be submitted for all potential applicants who are still under consideration to participate in the Games at the time of the respective accreditation deadline. In principle, applications for accreditation will not be accepted after this deadline. However, Responsible Organisations will generally be permitted to submit a long list of applications and subsequently

cancel applications after the deadline once they are identified as not participating in the Games.

The details in this document are correct as of July 2023 and they remain subject to change. The final requirements will be outlined in the Paris 2024 Accreditation Manuals that will be published at the launch of the application period for each stakeholder group.

Responsible Organisations are encouraged to contact the Accreditation team through the provided email addresses for any further questions.

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DATA FIELDS

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2. DATA FIELDS

The Data Fields table below lists the personal information that will be required for all applicants. Application forms will contain additional role-specific fields dependant on the accreditation category. For example, the 'Discipline' field will be a required field for Athletes. Details of any role-specific fields will be communicated in the respective Accreditation Manual for that population.

The 'Mandatory or Optional' column indicates whether a field is mandatory for submission of an application or is optional. Where there is an asterisk (*) then please note further details in the 'Additional Information' column. Optional fields must be left blank in the application form if not applicable. Do not enter 'same as above', 'idem', 'not applicable', 'n/a', etc.

The 'Format' column either displays a letter or the word 'CODE'. The letters A to F refer to a set of acceptable characters and formats. The 'CODE' refers to a defined list specific to that field. These codes sets can be found in the Appendix of this document.

The final column 'Population' indicates for which groups that data field is relevant for.

The values in the 'Format' column of the Data Fields table are explained here. The letters A to G refer to a set of acceptable characters which are outlined in the table below.

1 Both upper case and lower case Latin characters can be used when submitting applications for accreditation as the system will convert lower case characters to upper case where this is required.

2 The following diacritic (accented) characters have been checked and confirmed to be accepted by the accreditation system: ÁÀÂÃÄÅÆÇÐÉÈÊËËÏÎÏÑÓÒÔÕÖØÆΒΠÙÚÛÜÝ

3 Diacritic (accented) characters will be transliterated (converted) automatically to the equivalent non-diacritic Latin character upon submission of the application form. This is expected system behaviour so there is no need to contact us. The name printed onto the Accreditation Card will be generated before this conversion – i.e. the name printed onto the Accreditation Card will contain the diacritic (accented) characters.

Where the 'Format' column of the table indicates CODE or DATE, the required format depends on whether the application is being submitted using the single online application form, or in bulk using the Microsoft Excel template that will be provided.

4. IDENTITY DOCUMENTS

For each accreditation application the details of the applicant's identity document must be submitted. The table below lists the acceptable forms of identity document according to the applicant's nationality. These forms of identification are the only ones that can be used for the Paris 2024 Accreditation process.

→ Drivers Licence

Driving licences are not an accepted identification document for any nationality.

5. PHOTOGRAPH REQUIREMENTS

An essential part of the accreditation application is a photograph of the applicant. Failure to comply with the specificities required by Paris 2024 will delay the delivery of your accreditation. Please follow all the instructions below to ensure that your photograph is suitable the first time.

Each person will be required to submit a recent digital photographs (less than 6 months old) when applying for accreditation for the Olympic and Paralympic Games Paris 2024. This photograph will be printed on the accreditation card. It will also serve as a reference for the control procedures when accessing the competition venues and other secure venues of the Games.

For eligible persons in the Olympic or Paralympic Family categories who will receive a Pre Valid Card (PVC), applications for accreditation must include a passport-style photograph in accordance with the instructions below.

For all other persons, accreditation will only be issued once the photograph has been accepted by the Paris 2024 Accreditation team. Photographs must meet the minimum requirements below.

The photo must comply with the following 4 elements:

- It shows the participant in portrait orientation (examples below)
- It is in JPEG (.jpg or .jpeg), Portable Network Graphics (.png), High Efficiency Image Format (Heif) or Bitmap format (.Bmp).
- It has a maximum size of 2 MB (Megabyte). (Recommended size is between 500 Kb (Kilobyte) and 1 Mb)
- It must be at least 480 pixels wide and 600 pixels high. (ratio width / height of 4x5).

Please refer to the Appendix to see the examples of photos and more details on the Accreditation Applications Photographs Guide

5.1 GENERAL

The quality of a photograph taken with the camera from a smartphone, a basic digital camera or a webcam is sufficient if the applicant is close enough to the camera so that the photo does not need to be significantly cropped.

The applicant's face must take up between 70 and 80% of the photograph (only the head and the top of the shoulders must appear).

5.2 INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION

When an application is made individually, the original photograph does not need to be resized in height/width. The system offers a feature to crop the photograph before saving the application form.

The pixel dimensions of the original photograph file must, however, be large enough to ensure that the photograph attached to the application is larger than 480 pixels (width) and 600 pixels (height) after cropping.

The photo must meet the following three criteria:

- It shows the participant in portrait orientation (example below)
- It is in JPEG (.jpg or .jpeg), High Efficiency Image Format (.heif), Portable Network Graphics (.png) or Bitmap (.Bmp) format
- It has a maximum size of 2MB (Megabyte) (Recommended size between 500KB (Kilobyte) and 1MB)

5.3 BULK UPLOAD APPLICATION

When photos are imported at the same time with the data via a bulk upload process, the organisation managers must prepare the photos before importing them.

The photo must meet the following four criteria:

- It shows the participant in portrait orientation (example below)
- It is in JPEG (.jpg or .jpeg), Portable Network Graphics (.png), High Efficiency Image Format (.heif) or Bitmap (.bmp) format
- It has a maximum size of 2MB (Recommended size between 500KB and 1MB)
- It must be at least 480 pixels wide and 600 pixels high. (Width to height ratio of 4x5).

The bulk photo upload process will be explained in the system guide. The naming of the photos must follow certain rules: no spaces and no special characters. Paris 2024 recommends naming the photo as LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME.JPG.

Example: De Lattre De Tassigny Jean-Joseph
DELATTREDETASSIGNY_JEAN-JOSEPH.JPG

5.4 SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

All examples are given below of this guide.

→ Expression: the applicant must:

- Face forward, looking straight into the camera without tilting their head
- Have a neutral facial expression and mouth closed
- Be the only person in the photo and remain in the centre of the photo
- Keep both eyes open and clearly visible (red eyes are prohibited in photos)
- Consider tying long hair back; hair must not cover the applicant's eyes
- Not wear coloured contact lenses
- The face must be fully visible; scarves or other clothing and accessories must not hide the chin.

→ Style and brightness: the photograph must:

- Be a recent photograph of the applicant; it must have been taken within the last six months
- Have a plain white or light-coloured background
- Be in colour, not black and white
- Be taken in even light, with no shadows on the applicant's face or eyes, and exposing the skin tone naturally
- Not be overexposed or underexposed
- Not have the reflection of the camera flash on the applicant's face or on their eyeglasses
- Not be a selfie. Most cell phone cameras reverse left and right (mirror effect) when the front camera is used to take pictures.

→ Photograph quality: the photo must:

- Be sharp and clear
- Be in high resolution (must not be pixelated)
- Not be modified or altered digitally in any way for the purpose of enhancing the applicant's appearance (including use of filters, adjustment or removal of the background, adjustment of brightness or contrast, etc.)
- Not be squashed or stretched in such a way that the dimensions of the face are distorted
- Not be wrinkled or damaged (when you scan or photograph an existing photo). The final photo must be cropped and meet all other criteria.

→ Eyeglasses and headgear:

- The applicant must not wear a hat, a headband, an oversized hair accessory,

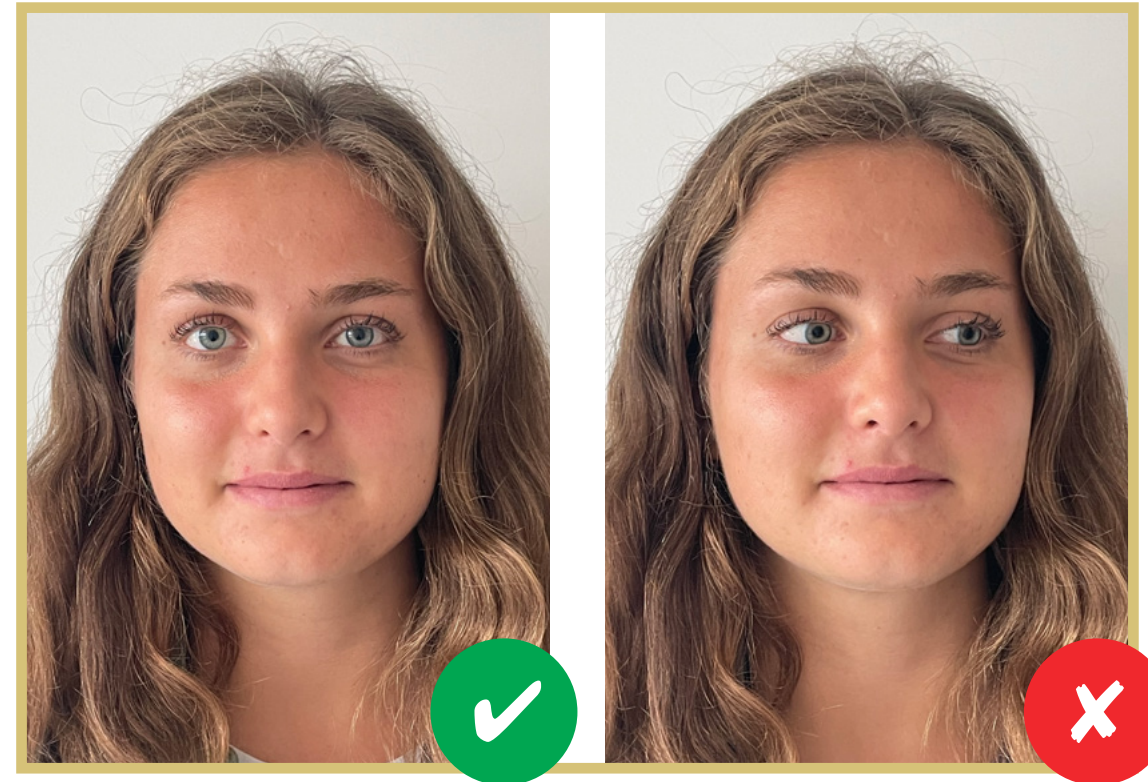
a wig, or any other headgear, except for religious or medical reasons.

- If the applicant wears headgear for religious reasons, it must not hide the face. Facial features from the top of the forehead to the bottom of the chin and the sides of the face must be clearly visible.
- If the applicant wears eyeglasses, they may keep them on in the photograph, but their eyes must be clearly visible. The eyeglass frame must not obscure the eyes, even partially, and there must be no glare or shine on the lenses or the frame in the photo. Avoid frames that are too thick.
- Sunglasses or tinted glasses are prohibited.
- Applicants whose eyes or part of their face are covered by bandages for medical reasons may have their photo taken with these bandages if these also appear on the passport photograph.

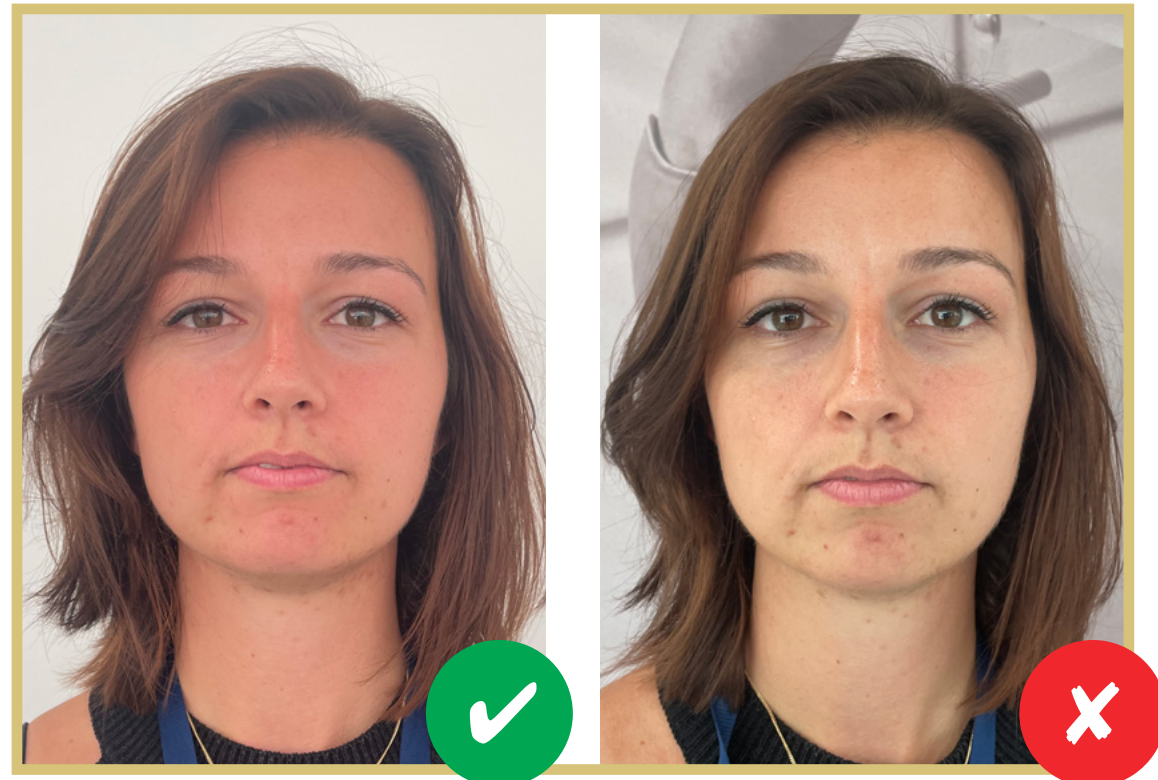

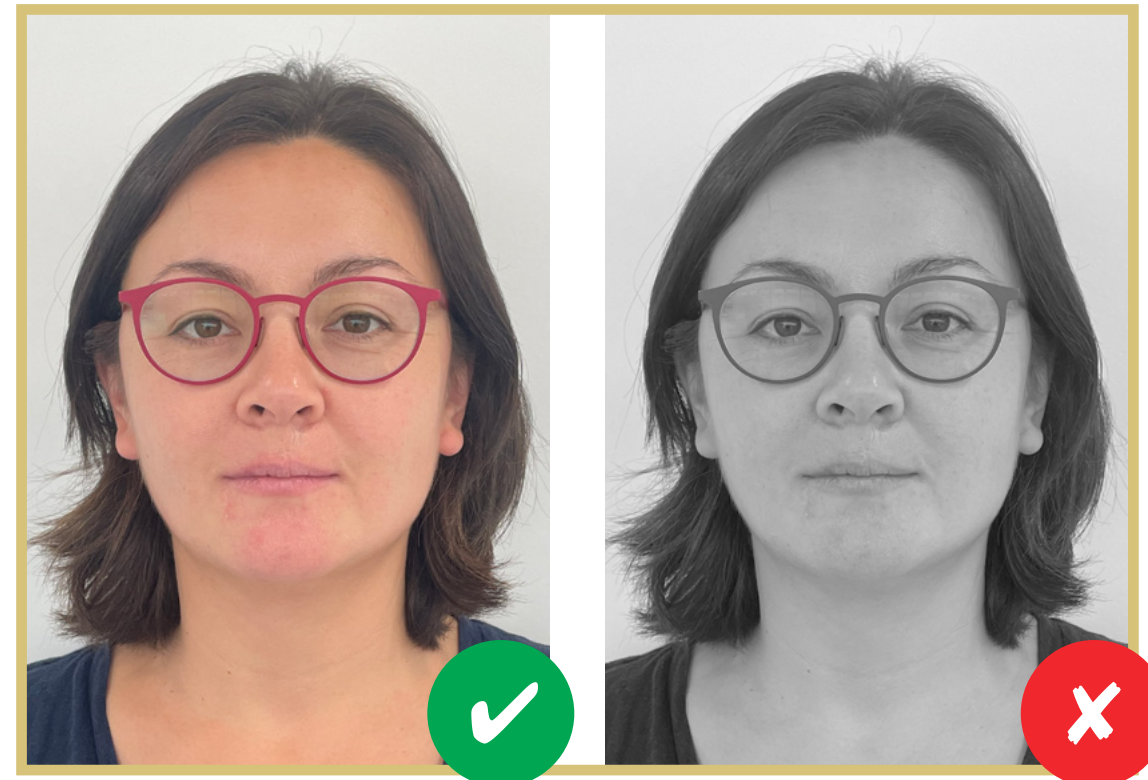

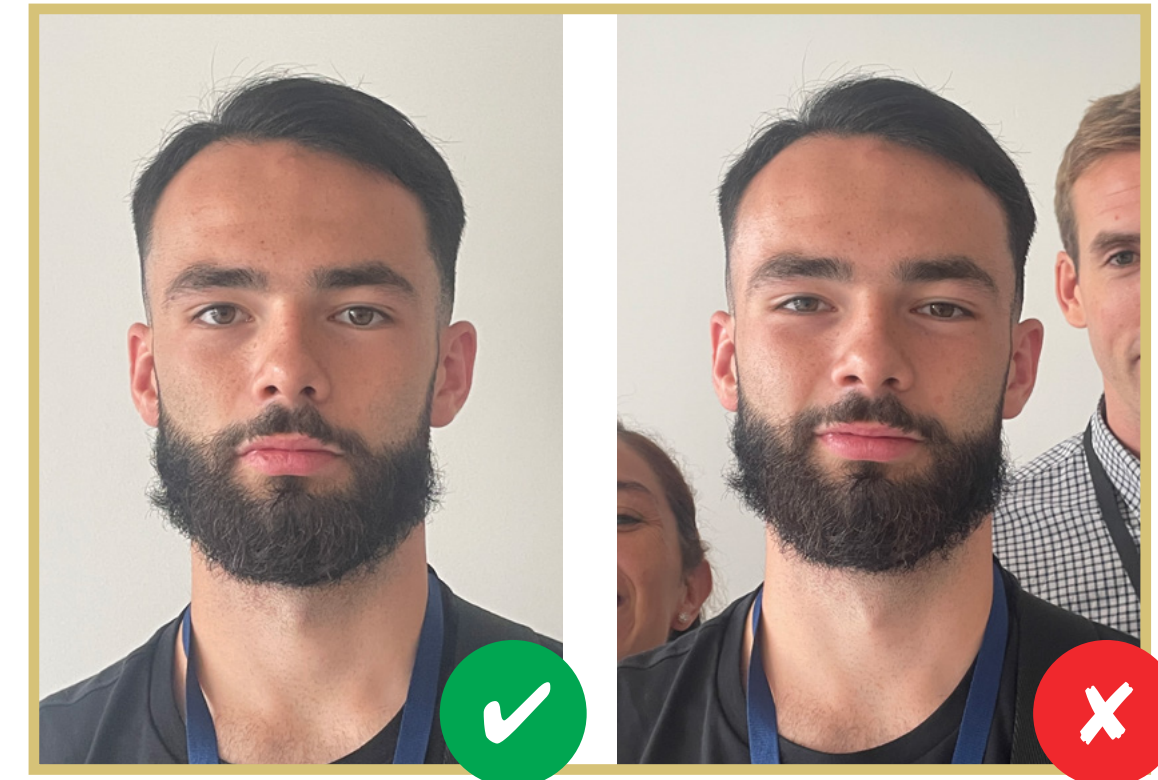
The applicant must face forward, not side-on



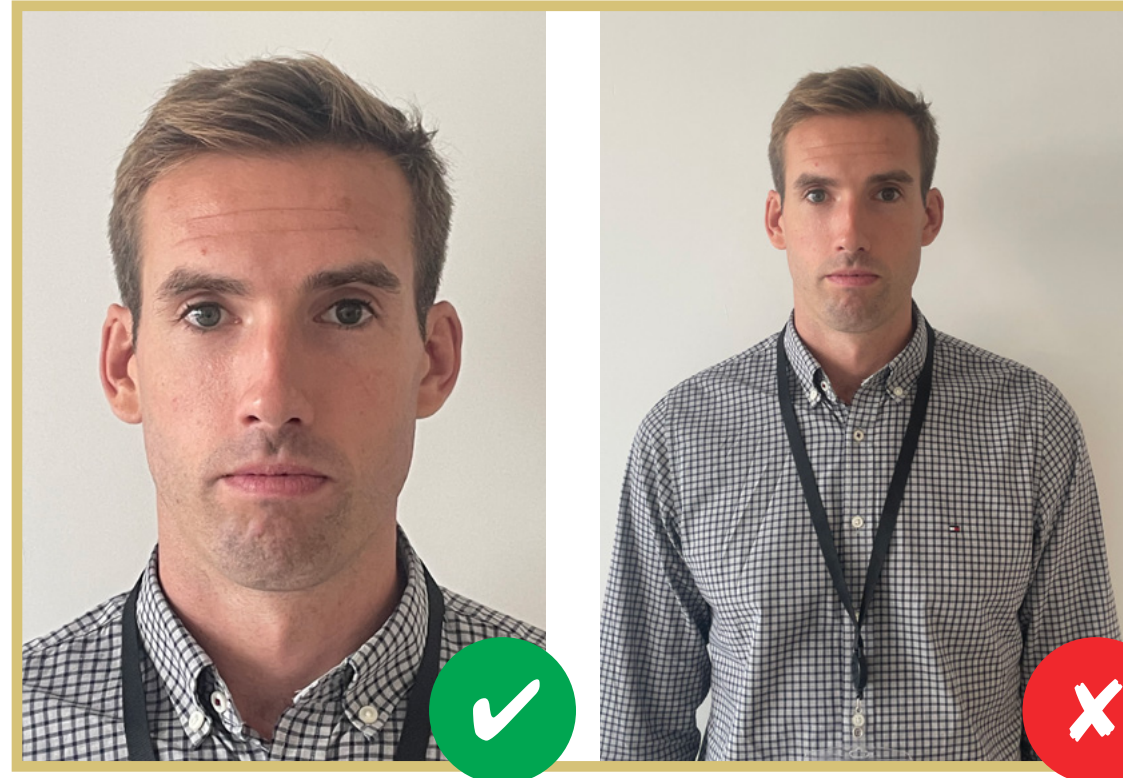
The photo background must be white or light-coloured and even



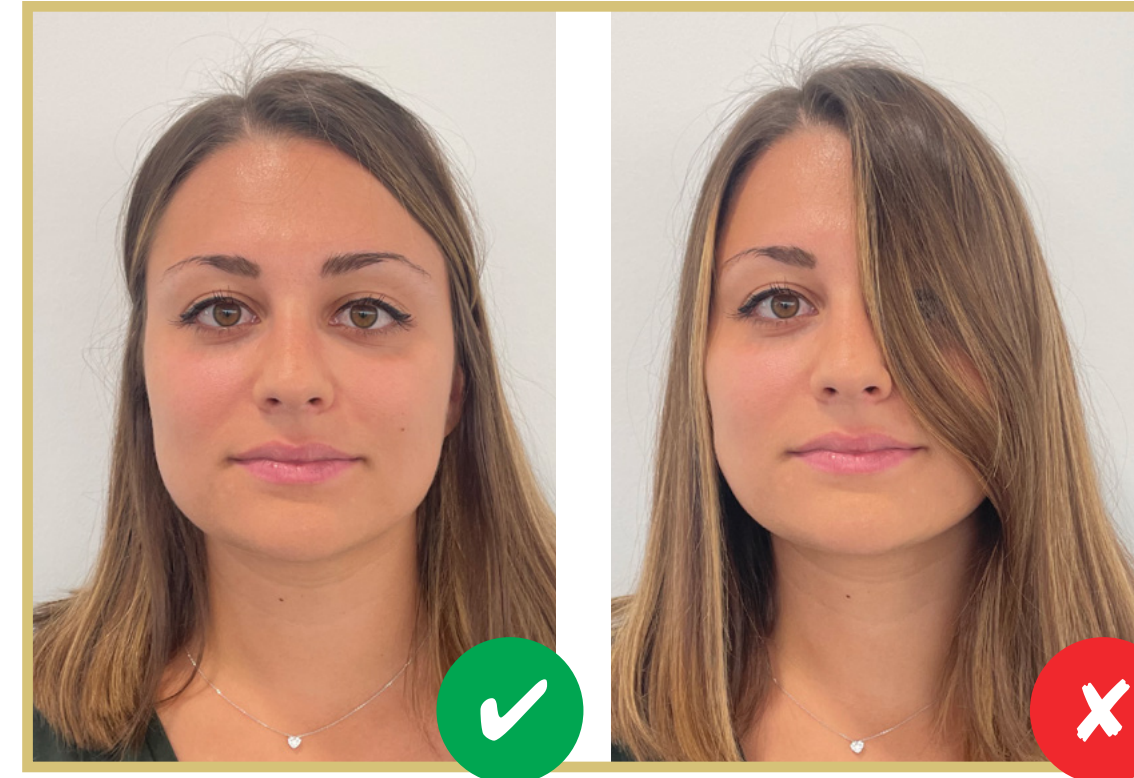
The photo must be in colour



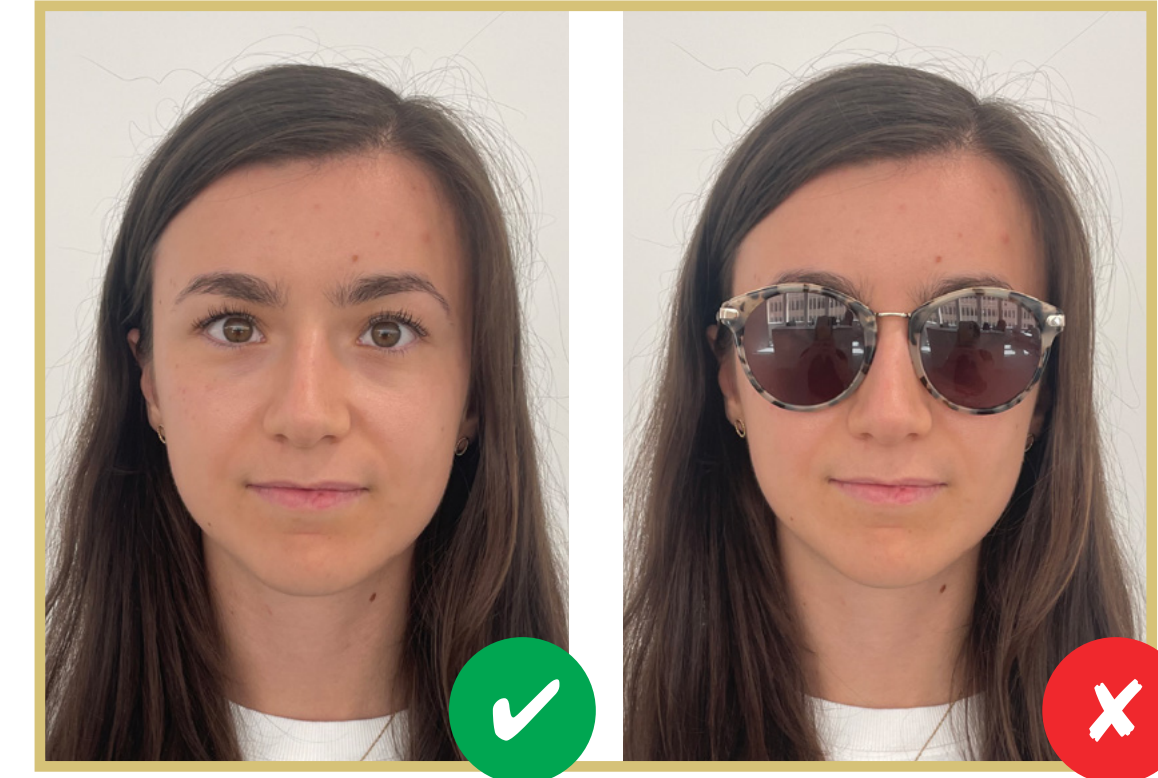
The applicant must be the only person in the photo



The applicant's face must take up between 70 and 80% of the photo



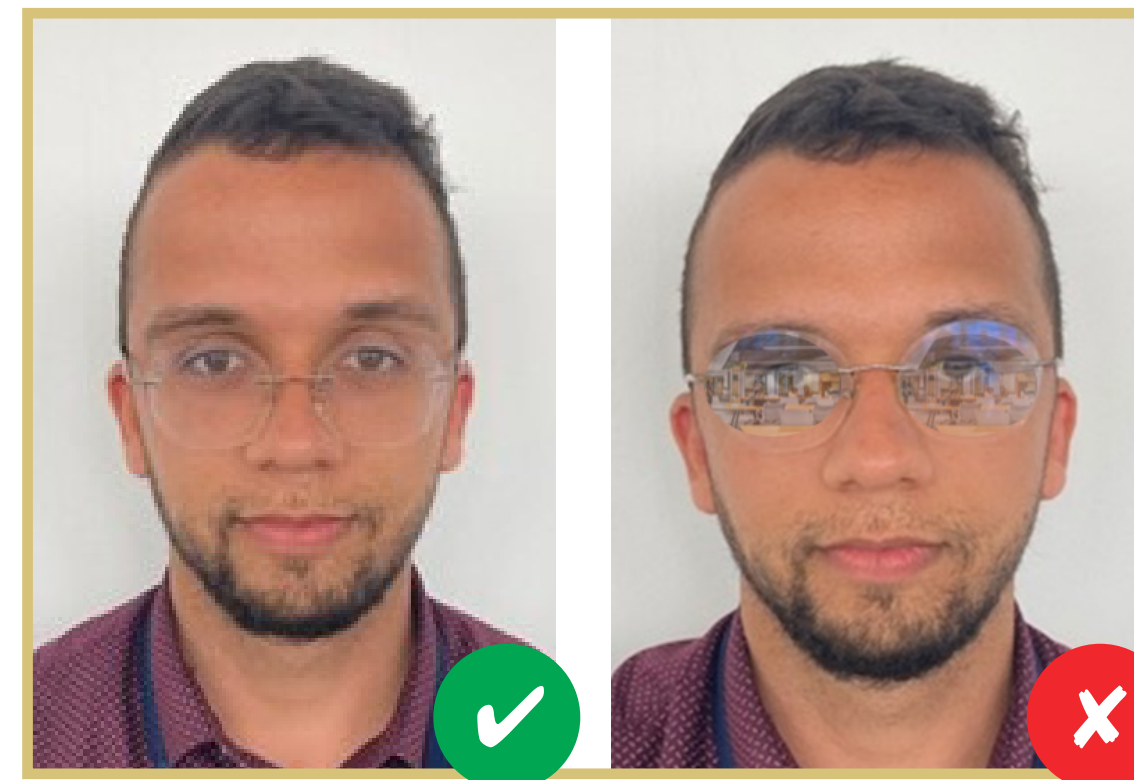
Hair must be pulled back from face



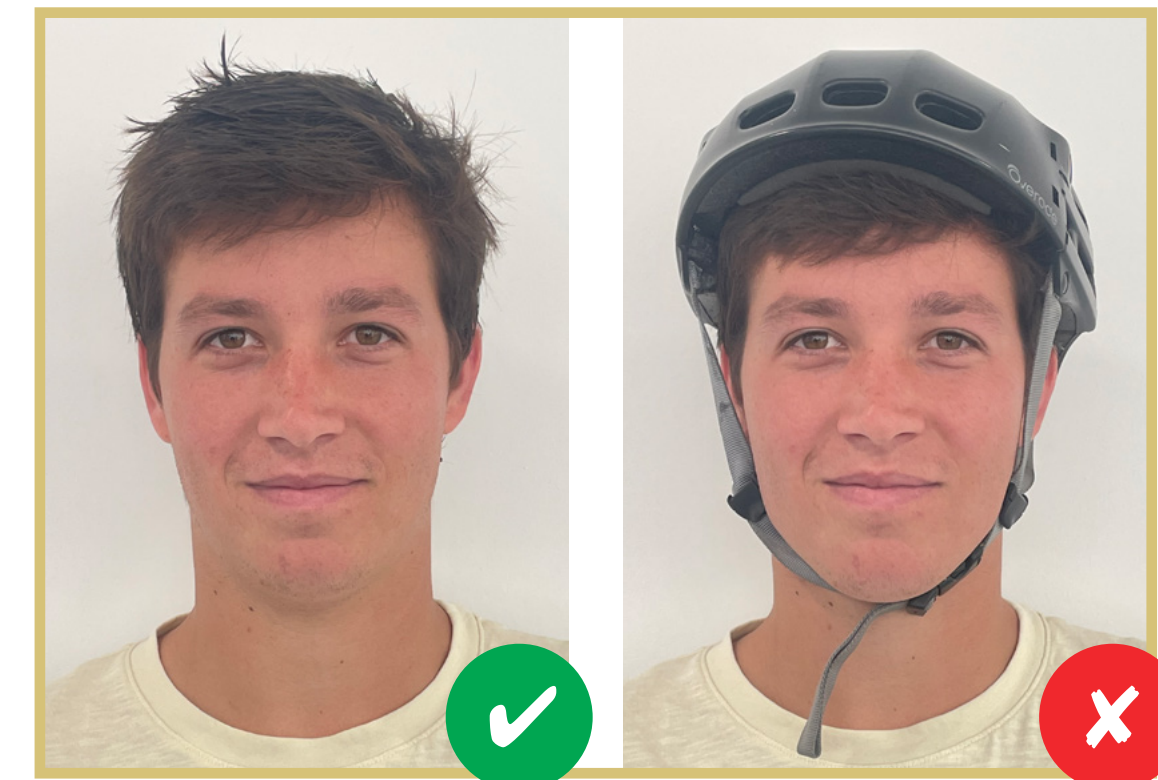
The applicant must not wear accessories covering their eyes (sunglasses)



The applicant's face must not be covered by a mask or any other item



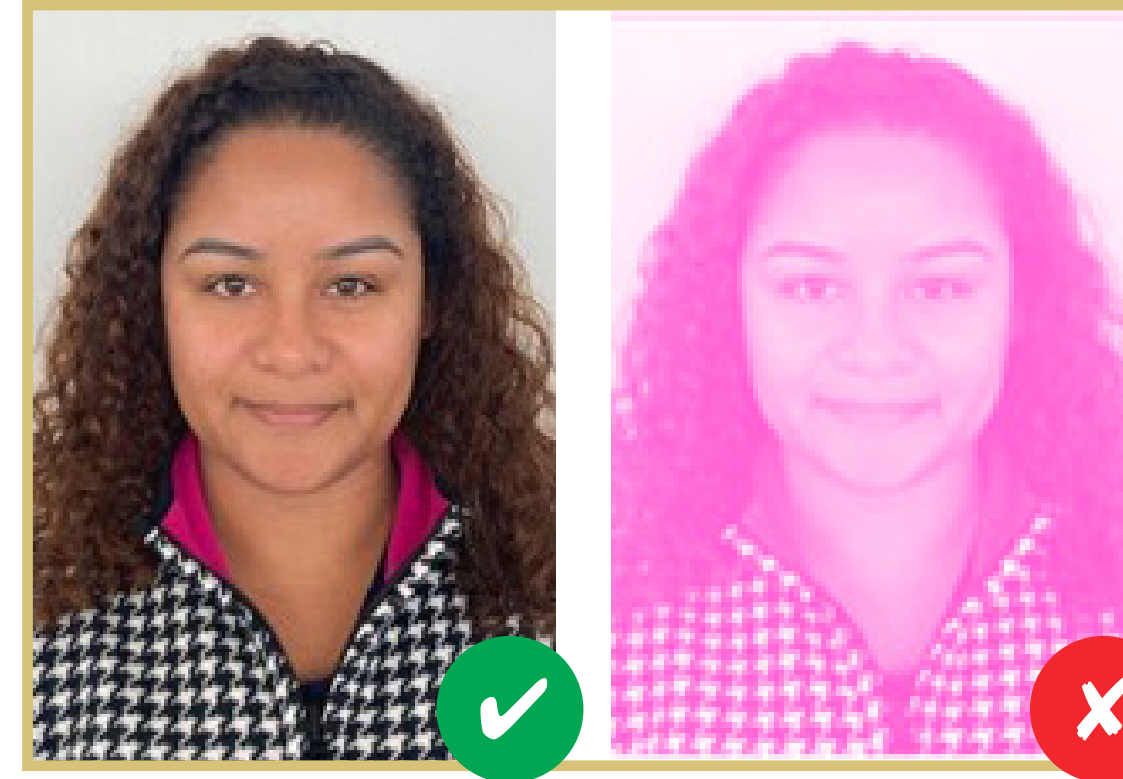
The applicant must not be wearing tinted or dark glasses. Lenses must be clear with no glare and not conceal the eyes

The photo must not be squashed or stretched



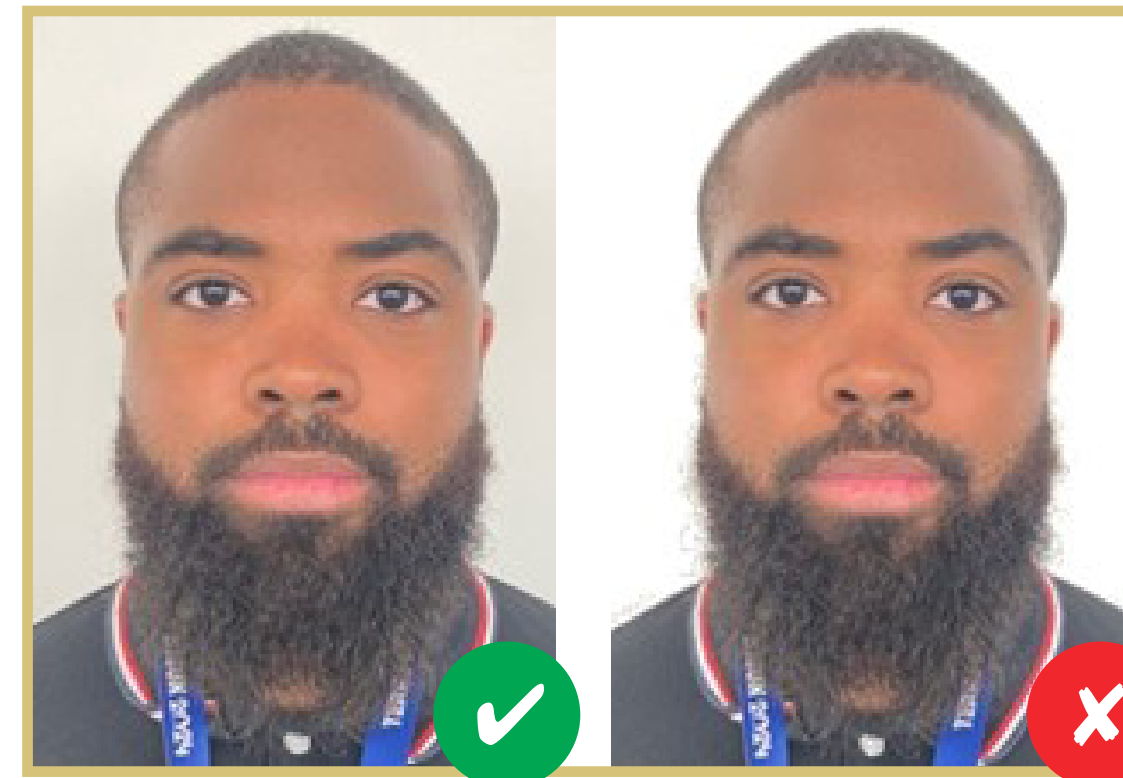
The photo must not use a filter or be digitally enhanced

The photo must not be overexposed



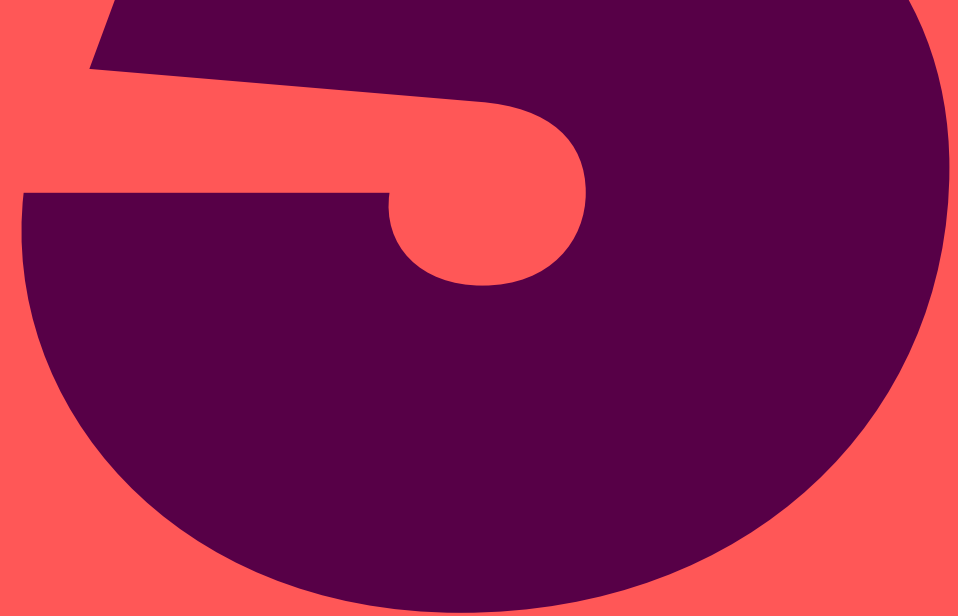
The photo must be taken with uniform light and no shadows

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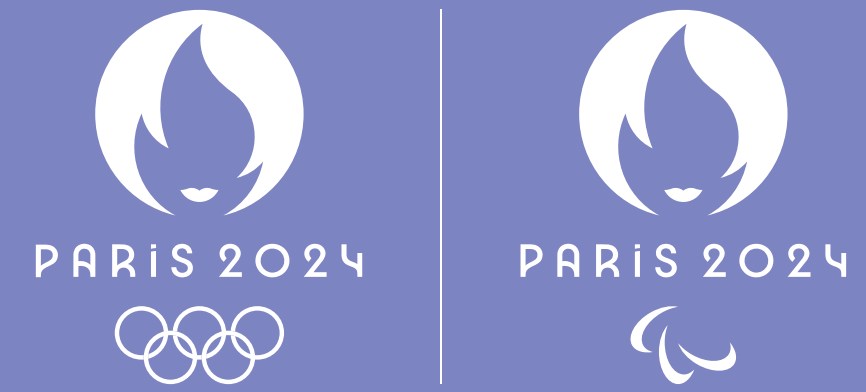


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
