

1.1 World Masters Athletics Championships

The World Masters Athletics Championships (WMAC) are held biannually. The WMAC are open only to men and women who are aged 35 years and over at the first day of competition and who are medically fit to compete. The upcoming event in Gothenburg will mark the 25th edition of the championships.

1.3 Eco-responsibility

Protecting the environment is becoming increasingly important in everyone's life, and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) of the World Masters Athletics Championships (WMAC) is committed to conducting these Championships as responsible citizens of the world.

For the seventh year in a row, Gothenburg has been named the world's most sustainable destination according to the Global Destination Sustainability Index. Gothenburg has achieved several more accolades for its efforts within the field of sustainability during the last ten years such as being one of Europe's most climate neutral cities in 2022 as well as one of the winners of the European Capitals of Inclusion and Diversity Awards in 2022.

1.4 Host Country Sweden

Sweden, officially the Kingdom of Sweden, is a country in Northern Europe. Located on the Scandinavian Peninsula, it is bordered by Norway to the west and north, Finland to the east, and is connected to Denmark by a bridge-tunnel across the Öresund Strait. Sweden also has coastlines along the Baltic Sea to the east and the Kattegat and Skagerrak straits to the southwest. It includes numerous islands, notably Gotland and Öland. Sweden is the fifth-largest country by land area in Europe, covering an area of 450,295 sq km, and is the most populous country in the Nordic region, with a population of over 10 million. Its capital and largest city is Stockholm.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1.5 Host City Gothenburg

Göteborg, also known as Gothenburg in English, is Sweden's second-largest city and the fifth-largest in the Nordic region. The city is home to approximately 580,000 residents. Nestled on the west coast at the Göta River, the vibrant city traces its roots back to the visionary initiative of King Gustav II Adolf. In 1621, Göteborg was officially founded and granted city privileges, marking the beginning of a rich history that blends tradition with modernity.

Göteborg is often referred to as "Lilla London" (Little London) due to its historical commercial ties with the United Kingdom and its British-influenced architecture. The city is renowned for its rich cultural

scene, including numerous museums, theaters and the famous Liseberg amusement park. The presence of several universities, such as the University of Gothenburg and Chalmers University of Technology, also makes it a significant educational center in Sweden.

World Masters Athletics (WMA), originally established as the World Association of Veterans Athletes (WAVA), was founded on August 9, 1977 in Sweden. The organization plays a crucial role in the world of athletics for masters, which includes women and men aged 35 and over. WMA's primary responsibilities are to organize, regulate and manage athletic events for masters. It also sanctions the Masters Athletics World Championships and various other international competitions. Additionally, WMA ratifies and records masters world records in different five-year age categories, maintaining comprehensive statistics and best performance records. Beyond competition, WMA promotes friendship, understanding and cooperation among athletes through the spirit of masters athletics.



3.2 Slottsskogsvallen

Slottsskogsvallen, located in central Gothenburg and right next to the House of Athletics, will once again host the World Masters Athletics Championships. The stadium celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2023, and the city undertook extensive renovations to restore its historical and colorful glory. The tracks will be replaced just in time for the opening ceremony to ensure they are in perfect condition for the championship.

Set amidst the beautiful surroundings of the City Forest, Slottsskogsvallen will serve as the main stadium and the beating heart of the championship experience. Slottsskogsvallen and its surroundings are shown in Appendix 2.

3.3 Björlanda Athletics Center

Björlanda Athletics Center is located on the north side of the river and is a brand-new stadium designed for modern competitions. Built for the World Masters Athletics Championships and the future of the sport, it boasts impressive facilities and infrastructure.

The stadium is the largest of its kind in northern Europe, optimized for competitions at all levels. It includes all necessary service facilities, making it an ideal venue. Despite its location, free shuttles for athletes and accompanying persons from the main stadium will be provided for easy access. 3.4 Ullevi Stadium

Ullevi Stadium, located in central Gothenburg, is a prominent multi-purpose venue with a rich history of hosting iconic sporting events. Originally built for the 1958 FIFA World Cup, it has also hosted the 1995 World Athletics Championships and the 2006 European Athletics Championships. The stadium's 9-lane tracks have been recently renovated, making them ready to host some of the track events during the championships. Ullevi Stadium and its surroundings are shown in Appendix 4.

3.5 Slottsskogen City Park

Slottsskogen City Park is one of Sweden's oldest, largest and most beloved city parks. Since 1874, its lush flora and fauna have made it the locals' top pick for a sunny day.

The park is located in the city center and right next to our main stadium. During the championships, it will serve as the venue for the 10K Road Walk, 20K Road Walk, 10K Road Run, Half Marathon, and Cross Country competitions. Slottsskogen City Park and its surroundings are described further in the section on Non-Stadia Competitions.

4. TRANSPORT

4.1 Arrival by Air

Traveling from Landvetter Airport to Göteborg City Center is simple and convenient. Various transportation options are available for travel from the airport to the city center including rental cars, taxi services and buses located just outside the arrival hall. The journey takes approximately 20 minutes. Airport Coaches (Flygbussarna), offering shuttle buses with multiple stops in the city, provides an option at around €12 (129 SEK). Tickets can be purchased in advance online or on-site.

4.2 Arrival by Road

Gothenburg is easily accessible by car. The city is well-connected to the European road network, with major highways converging in the region. E6, a significant north-south route, links Gothenburg to Oslo and Copenhagen, while the E20 connects the city to Stockholm and the rest of the Swedish road network. Please note that Gothenburg has a congestion charge system, so be prepared for tolls when driving in and out of the city center. At all our competition venues, parking facilities are provided and are subject to a fee.





4. TRANSPORT

4.3 Arrival by Rail

The city boasts excellent rail connections, with the Central Station (Göteborgs Centralstation) serving as a major transportation hub. High-speed trains from major European cities and well-connected regional lines make traveling by rail a convenient option. Once you arrive at the Central Station, you are just a short distance from the competition venues. The main stadium is easily accessible via a guick tram or bus ride.

4.4 Transport to the Competition Venues

Transportation around the city, including travel to the competition venues, is the responsibility of the athletes. Free public transportation is not provided. However, the LOC supports the use of the public transportation system, which is extensive, with over 200 trams and 133 stops.

Once you enter the city, the efficient public transportation system makes it easy to explore and move around. Trams, buses and ferries weave through Gothenburg, ensuring you can effortlessly reach every corner of the city and its surrounding areas. The public transportation system is operated by Västtrafik. Their app, *Västtrafik Travel Planner*, is an excellent tool for finding and planning your journeys. Our venue maps include information about the nearest stops to each competition site.

4.5 Stadium to Stadium Travel

The organizer provides a free shuttle bus service to and from Slottsskogsvallen, Björlanda Athletics Center and Ullevi Stadium. This service is available to all accredited individuals including athletes, team members, accompanying persons and officials. Buses depart from each drop-off and pick-up point every half hour. The timetable and route information can be found in Appendix 6. For Non-Stadia events in Slottsskogen, it is just a short walk from the main stadium.

4.6 Team Transportation Offer

Our official transportation partner Västanhede offers the perfect solution for airport transfers for larger teams or groups. Book a private transfer bus to ensure a smooth and hassle-free journey. These buses can accommodate up to 50 passengers. To express your interest, please email transportation@2024wmac.com and include the following information:

Your booking will be confirmed via email. The last day to express interest is July 30. The price for a one-way ride is €450 (4 900 SEK) per bus.

4.7 Parking at the Competition Venues

Parking facilities are provided at all competition venues and are subject to a fee.

Slottsskogsvallen & House of Athletics

Participant and visitor parking is available directly adjacent to the venues. Detailed information is specified in the layout of the Athletes' Village in Appendix 5. A daily fee of €6 (65 SEK) applies, and parking can be paid for with cash or via Swish.

Björlanda Athletics Center

Free participant and visitor parking is located 500 meters from the competition venue. Limited paid parking is available right across the street from the stadium at a rate of €0.70 (8 SEK) per per hour. Payment can be made at the regular parking meters or via the *Parkering Göteborg* app. This parking is managed by the city's regular parking system and is not overseen by the organizer. For details, please refer to the layout of the Björlanda Athletics Center in Appendix 3.

Ullevi Stadium

Participant and visitor parking is available directly adjacent to the competition venue. There is also an underground parking garage at the stadium. A fee applies at a rate of €2.40 (25 SEK) per hour, and payment is made at the regular parking meters or via the *Parkering Göteborg* app. This parking is managed by the city's regular parking system and is not overseen by the organizer.





4.8 Transportation of Vaulting Poles

Each athlete is responsible for organizing transportation of their poles until arrival to the competition venue.

5. ACCREDI-TATION

In general, an accreditation card is proof of authority to access specific zones to carry out a function. It will contain numbered Accreditation Zones, indicating the specific access privileges for the holder.

All athletes, team managers, accompanying persons and registered team support personnel will receive an accreditation card, which must always be worn and clearly visible. The accreditation is not transferable and does not allow the holder to take another person beyond checkpoints. The holder is granted access rights only to the zones indicated on the front and shall use the designated entrances accordingly. Only athletes who are about to compete will have access to the Call Room and to the infield – escorted by the Officials. A replacement for a lost or damaged accreditation pass can be purchased at Accreditation Centre for €20 (200 SEK).

6. TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTER

The TIC is located in the House of Athletics and serves as the main service and information hub for all participants. The main function of the Technical Information Center is to ensure smooth communication between each athlete and team delegations, the LOC, World Masters Athletics and the Competition Management. It will operate from one hour before the first event until one hour after the last event. The layout and design of the TIC are shown in the Stadium Laour for the House of Athletics in Appendix 1.

7. CHAMPIONSHIP MEETINGS

7.1 Team Managers Meetings

The Team Managers Meeting Room is located on the second floor of the House of Athletics, next to the main stadium. The first Team Managers Meeting will be held on Monday, 12 August at 15:00, before the opening ceremony.

Starting from Wednesday, 14 August, Team Managers Meetings will be held daily at 09:00 in the Team Managers Meeting Room.

There will be no Team Managers Meeting on the non-competition days, 16 August and 21 August, nor on the last day of competition, Sunday 25 August.

Team Managers must submit all questions using the Team Managers Form by 18:00 at the TIC. Reports from the daily Team Managers Meetings will be posted on the 2024 WMAC official website.

7.2 Officials Briefings

All Officials Briefings will take place on 12 August at the House of Athletics before the opening ceremony. All technical officials attending the briefing are requested to collect their accreditations at the volunteers service center before the meeting starts. For more details, please visit the 2024 WMAC official website and the Championship Team section.

7.3 WMA Meetings

The WMA General Assembly is a meeting held in conjunction with each WMA World Championship Stadia and consists of the WMA Council and the delegates appointed by Affiliates.

At a General Assembly, Council Officers' reports are presented for approval, WMA Office Bearers are elected and proposed amendments to the Constitution, Bye-Laws or Rules of Competition are agreed or rejected according to the voting rules. Bids to host future WMA championships are also sanctioned.

Other interested parties may attend the General Assembly but do not have voting rights.

The WMA General Assembly will be held at Ullevi Lounge at Ullevi Stadium, on Friday 16 August 2024 commencing at 09:00. Delegate registration will commence from 07:30 and Delegates must be seated by 08:50. Up to 160 participants are expected to attend.

7.4 Committee and Regional Meetings

Regional and Committee meetings will be held in several rooms at the House of Athletics on Wednesday, 21 August 2024, at designated times. These times will be posted for team managers at the Team Managers Meetings and on the LOC official information board. Separate team meetings for countries can be booked through the TIC.

8. ATHLETES' STEPS TO COMPETE

STEP 1

Visit the Technical Information Center (TIC) at the House of Athletics to obtain your Athletes' Registration Pack and your Accreditation Pass. The Athletes' Registration Pack will include two competition bibs, safety pins and a bag tag to attach to your bag. To collect your Registration Pack and Accreditation Pass, you must present a passport or other government-issued identification with picture included.

STEP 2

Confirm your participation by 17:00 the day before your event. Exceptions are the non-stadia events, which do not require confirmation. You can confirm your participation in two ways:

Option 1: Through the Roster Athletics app. A confirmation receipt will be sent to you via email.

Online self-confirmation opens on 25 July 2024. Instructions for confirming your participation online can be found in Appendix 7.





Option 2: In person at the Confirmation Desk in the TIC area. You will receive a paper receipt directly upon confirmation at the TIC.

STEP 3

A Call Room will be conducted at each venue. Athletes must report to the Call Room by the scheduled time for each event. The location of the Call Room is specified on each competition venue layout.

9. SECURITY

9.1 General Information

The safety and security of all guests at the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships is a top priority. Contracted security officers and volunteers will maintain the security of all competition venues during the day and overnight.

Enhanced security measures will be in place, including increased access controls. All participants may be subject to bag checks and other security screenings upon entering the venues.

If you witness any incidents related to security, please report them immediately to event staff or the nearest security guard. It is important to report every incident, suspected or real, to enable decision-makers to take action to protect all participants at the championships.

9.2 Prohibited Items and Practices

The following items and practices are prohibited at the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships competition and event venues:

- Glass objects
- Explosive devices
- Large banners or banners with commercial messages or offensive references
- The distribution of flyers or any materials not approved by the 2024 Gothenburg LOC
- · Unauthorised tables or stands
- Items or practices forbidden by law in Sweden

9.3 Secure Bag Drop

Secure bag drop areas will only be available at non-stadia events.

9.4 Lost Property

Items found during the event will be stored at the welcome desk at each venue until the end of each competition day. Each night, lost property will be transported to the TIC at the House of Athletics. To recover any lost items, please make inquiries at either the venue welcome desk or the service desk within the TIC.

9.5 Competition Safety Officers

The WMA Council has appointed a Safety Director who has overall responsibility for the safety of athletes competing in the championships, safety aspects at competition venues and generally ensuring the overall safety of all aspects of the competition. The Safety Director will be supported by a team of Safety Officers appointed by WMA and the LOC. Safety Officers have the authority to withdraw from competition any athlete whose continued participation in the competition would, in the opinion of the Safety Officers, endanger the athlete's health and/ or the safety of the other competitors. The decision to withdraw an athlete from any competition may be exercised by the Safety Director, a Safety Officer or through Deputies appointed to assist the Safety Officers.

Wherever possible the Safety Officers will consult with a medical representative before taking action to withdraw an athlete from competition. Safety Officers and any appointed Deputies will be clearly identified.

9.6 Withdrawal Procedure

Safety Officers or their appointed Deputies will initially orally speak with the athlete to alert them of safety or health concerns, or, if appropriate, issue a yellow card warning to the athlete. If the concerns continue and a decision is taken to remove the athlete from the competition because of health and or safety reasons, a RED card will be shown to the athlete as well as an oral instruction, advising that the athlete has been disqualified. The athlete must then immediately cease to participate in the event and leave the competition area.





10. MEDICAL SERVICES

10.1 Emergency Number

In case of any emergency in Sweden, dial 112. This is the national emergency number and can be used for urgent assistance from the police, fire department or medical services. The operator will direct your call to the appropriate emergency service. The 112 number is available 24/7 and can be called from any phone, free of charge.

10.2 Health Advice

All international visitors are strongly advised to obtain travel insurance, including medical coverage, prior to arriving in Sweden.

10.3 Medical Services at the Competition Venues

First aid services will be available at each competition venue throughout all competition days. Trained first aid personnel will be present from before the first event until after the last. They will circulate around the stadiums to ensure quick accessibility and will also have a primary fixed station marked by dark green beach flags with "Sjukvård" in white, easily identifiable on stadium maps.

Additionally, first aid personnel will be on hand for all non-stadia events, primarily stationed at the start and finish areas.

All personnel will carry defibrillators, which are also located at the House of Athletics and all call rooms. The exact locations of defibrillators are indicated on each stadium map.

10.4 Medical Facilities in Gothenburg

In case of any medical needs during your stay, Gothenburg has several top-tier hospitals ready to assist you. Sahlgrenska University Hospital (Blå Stråket 5, 413 45 Gothenburg), one of the largest in Northern Europe, provides comprehensive specialized services. Östra Hospital (Diagnosvägen 11, 416 50 Gothenburg, known for its excellent maternity and pediatric care, and Mölndal Hospital (Göteborgsvägen 31, 431 30 Mölndal), specializing in orthopedics, geriatrics, and rehabilitation, are also part of the Sahlgrenska network. Remember to carry your identification and event accreditation when visiting any medical facility.

10.5 Team Support Personnel Services and Physiotherapy Provisions

Dedicated areas will be available at each competition venue for team support personnel, such as masseurs and physiotherapists, to set up their working stations. The largest hub will be located at Slottsskogsvallen, indoors and adjacent to the competition area. At Björlanda Athletics Center and Ullevi Stadium, this facility will be offered in dedicated dressing rooms if space permits; otherwise, it will be available outdoors. Only accredited team support personnel will have access to these areas.

The LOC will also provide physiotherapy services in the main stadium for countries that do not have their own physiotherapy support. A booking service for these services will be located at the General Information Desk at the TIC.

10.6 Massage Service

A massage service will be available for all participants at the House of Athletics. Bookings can be made on-site and are subject to availability. The cost is approximately €22.50 (250 SEK) for a 20-minute session. The service, provided by Flexmassage, operates from 11:00-18:00 on competition days.

11. CEREMONIES

11.1 Opening Ceremony

We welcome all athletes, officials and supporters to our official Opening Ceremony at the main stadium. This will be a truly unforgettable evening where we celebrate unity, share our passion and kick off the entire World Masters Athletics Championships together. Key details are as follows:

Athletes participating in the team parade should gather and check in outside the stadium at the designated location close to the call room at 17:30. The Athletes' Parade will commence shortly after 18:00. Countries will enter the stadium in alphabetical order, with the host country, Sweden, making a grand entrance as the final participant in the Team Parade.

11.2 Closing Ceremony

We invite all athletes, officials and supporters to join us for the official Closing Ceremony at Medal Plaza. Key details are as follows:

Date: Sunday 25 August **Time:** Starts at 17:00

11.3 The Medal Ceremony

The medal ceremony is a moment frozen in time where competitors, spectators and the spirit of the sport come together. Each medal represents not just an achievement, but also the stories of challenges overcome, hours of hard training and the unbreakable spirit of the athletes. Welcome to help us in honoring our medalists at the Medal Plaza in the Athletes' Village.

All medal ceremonies, regardless of the competition venue, will take place at Medal Plaza in the Athletes' Village, located just outside the gates of the main stadium.

A daily timetable for medal ceremonies will be published on the official championship website and be displayed on the official LOC information board in the TIC. Athletes are requested to attend the medal ceremony in an outfit representative of their country. National flags are not allowed during the medal presentation.

During the ceremony, medals will be given to the top three athletes. The winner's national anthem will be played. Diplomas for the top three athletes can be collected in the TIC.

A medal ceremony may be delayed if there is an appeal regarding the results.

Should an athlete not be able to attend their medal ceremony, they may collect the medal from the medal collection desk at the TIC after the ceremony. Team Managers are also permitted to collect medals on behalf of their athletes.

Medal engraving is available for booking at the TIC.

12. ARENA RESTAURANTS AND COFFEE SHOPS


18.1 Media Enquiries

18.2 Media Access

All media representatives attending the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships must be accredited. Media accreditation passes grant access to the Press Stand and Media Zones or Media Centers at the competition venues. Please refer to the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships Media Guidelines, available on the official championship website, for more details.

19. ENTRIES AND CONFIRMATION

19.1 Final Entries

Refer to the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships official website: www.2024wmac.com.

19.2 Confirmation of Entries

Athletes MUST confirm their participation for each event entered, before the beginning of the first round or the first event of the combined event in the competition. All confirmations must be completed by 17:00 the day before event.

You can confirm your participation in two ways:

Option 1: Online through the Roster Athletics app. A confirmation receipt will be sent to you via email. Online self-confirmation opens on 25 July 2024. The deadline for confirmation is 17:00 the day before your event. Instructions for confirming your participation using the Roster Athletics app can be found in Appendix 7.

Option 2: In person at the TIC. You will receive a paper receipt directly upon confirmation at the TIC.

Please Note: There is NO confirmation required for any non-stadia event.

19.3 Change of Events

Participants are **not** allowed to change or add events. Athletes may only cancel their registered events through the Roster Athletics app or in person at the TIC.

Important reminders

- An athlete cannot take the place of another athlete in any event.
- Non-compliance with these rules may result in disqualification from the entire competition.

20. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

20.1 Rules of Competition

The World Masters Athletics Championships are governed by the WMA rules of Competition and the technical rules of World Athletics (WA). The WMA Competition Rules are available online at www. world-masters-athletics.org.

20.2 Competition Schedule

The competition schedule, organized by day and site, is provided in Appendix 8 and is also available on the official championship website.

20.3 Schedule Changes

Any change to the competition program will be discussed during the daily Team Managers Meetings and/or through an official notice displayed on the official LOC information boards at each venue. No event will start earlier than the scheduled time on the program.

20.4 Language

Swedish and English will be the primary languages spoken in all 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships Call Rooms. Where possible, French, Spanish and German speaking officials could be available in the Call Rooms. If necessary, athletes may report to the Call Room with an accredited translator.

20.5 Uniform

In WMA Championships, all athletes **MUST** wear a competition top that is approved by their national Masters Member. In WMA Championships where team events are contested, or where an athlete does not have an affiliated Masters Member, it is mandatory to wear a uniform clearly identifying the country that the athlete represents, and which must be accepted by the Call Room Referee or the WMA Technical Delegate. A Club singlet or vest is **NOT** acceptable.





20. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

All advertising on the uniforms of the athletes during the competition and the awards will be in accordance with the rules of World Athletics regarding size and content.

20.6 Competition Bibs

All athletes will receive two bibs and eight (8) pins, which must be collected from the Athletes' Registration Pack area in the TIC. Athletes will also receive a bag tag to label their bags.

In all competitions, the athlete must wear two bibs, properly attached to their competition top, with one bib on the front and one on the back. The exception is for jumps and throws, where the bib may be placed on the front or back or both.

The bibs must not be cut, bent or otherwise modified, under penalty of disqualification. In relay events, athletes wear their own bibs.

Any replacement bib will be charged at a fee of €10 (100 SEK) without a UHF tag (timing chip) and €20 (200 SEK) with a UHF tag. Replacement bibs can be purchased only from the TIC. Payment by cash only.

20.7 Personal Items

Athletes are not allowed to bring or use tape recorders, radios, cell phones, headphones, cameras or any other electronic devices in the competition area. These items will be confiscated and can be recovered in the post-event control room at the end of the event.

Any advertising on athletes' uniforms or bags must comply with WA rules. Items not in compliance will be confiscated and returned at the end of the competition.

21. SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR ATHLETES AND FEDERATIONS

The Gothenburg Championships have exceptionally high entry numbers, requiring special regulations.

Special advancement tables will be used for certain events and distributed to athletes and team managers. More details about the advancement tables can be found under the Stadia Events section.

Athletes are reminded that competition pools are based on their submitted best performance. Those without a submitted performance will be placed in the weakest pool (Pool 1), which competes first. Stronger pools will follow, with the top eight (8) overall competitors advancing to the final three (3) rounds.

This seeding principle also applies to combined events. In vertical jumps with mixed age groups, all athletes will follow the same progression until winners are determined for each age group.





22. TIMING AND PERFORMANCE MEASURMENT

22.1 Results and Records

The WMA Records Officer automatically records the world records broken during the championships. Broken world records are also immediately visible in the results reporting via Roster Athletics. For enquiries about national records, athletes should contact their team manager.

22.2 Live Results

Live results will be available in the Roster Athletics app and on the official championship website: www.2024wmac.com. For more information, please refer to Appendix 9.

22.3 Post-Competition Procedures and Display of Results

All certified results will be available in the Roster Athletics app and on the official championship website: www.2024wmac.com. The daily results will be displayed on the official LOC information board.

23. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals must be made in compliance with the rules of the WA and WMA as modified below and appeals submitted no later than one (1) hours after the display of the results. Results will be displayed in the Roster Athletics app and on the official championship website. A Protest is an immediate disagreement about any aspect of any event. An appeal is a disagreement with a Referees' decision about a Protest. There cannot be an Appeal without a Protest being held and a Referee decision.

23.1 Protests

Protests concerning the status of an athlete to participate in the championships must be made to the Technical Delegate(s), prior to the commencement of the competition. If the issue remains unresolved to the athlete's satisfaction prior to the event's commencement, the athlete will be presented with a red and white card, indicating permission to compete "under protest". The problem will then be referred to the WMA Council for a final decision.

Protests concerning the conduct, or the result of an event should be made immediately to the Judge, preferably the Head Judge, of that event. Judges will do everything possible to preserve the rights of the athlete such as provisionally measuring throws or jumps.

23.2 Appeals

If an athlete disagrees with a decision made by the Referee, the athlete or their team manager may submit a written appeal to the Jury of Appeal. Appeals must be lodged at the TIC, or at the main secretariat at Björlanda Athletics Center and Ullevi Stadium. The time limit for lodging an appeal is one (1) hour from the time the results are posted. The Appeal panel will issue a written decision, which will be available at the TIC.

Appeals must be submitted in writing using the provided form. These forms can be requested from the TIC, the main secretariats at Björlanda Athletics Center or Ullevi Stadium, or downloaded online from the official championship website. The form should be signed by the team manager, the athlete, or an official acting on behalf of the athlete.

A deposit of €100 (1000 SEK) is required to confirm the appeal. If the appeal is not upheld, the deposit will not be returned. Payment must be made in cash only.





24. ANTI-DOPING PROCEDURES

24.1 Anti-doping Control

World Masters Athletics, in collaboration with Swedish Athletics and the LOC, has engaged the services of Swedish Anti-Doping (ADSE) to conduct drug testing as part of the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships. Testing will be carried out under WA/WMA Rules, in compliance with the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) provisions. Representatives from WMA and Swedish Anti-Doping will oversee the anti-doping operations.

24.2 Selection Procedures

If you are selected for a test, a clearly identified and accredited drug testing official (Chaperone) will inform you. You will be escorted to the testing control area for the doping test. Please note, refusing to take the test will be considered equivalent to a positive result.

24.3 Testing Procedures

The testing procedure will be fully explained to you by the control team. You may request information about the drug testing procedure at any time during or after completing the required forms. Any queries or complaints should be noted before signing the forms.

If you have been granted a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), carry a copy with you as proof when being tested and provide details on the drug testing form.

24.4 Athletes' Rights

An athlete is normally advised of their selection for a drug test immediately after they have completed an event. The drug testing official (DCO, Chaperone) who advises you of the selection will then remain with you until such time as you are presented at the testing control area.

You may nominate another person (one only) to accompany you to the drug testing process. With the consent of your drug testing official, and always in full view of the official, you may:

- Attend a victory ceremony
- Compete in future events
- · Receive necessary medical attention
- Fulfil media commitments
- · Warm down (cool off) or recuperate

24.5 Athletes' Responsibilities

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that the following is done during the sample collection process:

- You are aware of and comply with the WA/WMA/ WADA doping control regulations
- You comply with the drug testing procedure
- You control the urine sample until it is sealed in the sample collection kit
- The sealed sample collection kit is secured and identified
- All appropriate documentation is accurate, complete and signed

Note: If any part of the drug testing procedure concerns you it is recommended that you record your concern on the drug testing form and notify your Team Manager or Federation. This form should always be with you and should not be given to anyone else.







25. CALL ROOM

Once athletes have reported to the Call Room, they will not be permitted to leave. All necessary information concerning the competition will be provided to the athletes in the Call Room. The Call Room officials will verify the accreditation, competition number, uniform, shoes and personal effects of the athletes. All athletes will be escorted from the Call Room to the competition area.

Athletes must report to the Call Room at the latest at the times shown below:

26. COMPETITION SITE EXIT PROCEDURES

In the high jump and pole vault events, athletes are permitted to leave the competition area after they have been eliminated.

In the Combined Events, athletes will leave the track after the event with a Judge. There will be toilets available for athletes during the championship, but it is necessary to be accompanied by a Judge or a technical assistant to use the toilets during the competition.

All athletes must leave the competition area and proceed through the post-event area where athletes will collect their personal belongings.

27. SPIKES

The call room staff will be responsible for checking the spikes on the athletes' shoes. The maximum length spikes for track events will be 7mm, with 9mm for field events.

28. SOLES

All shoes in any event shall not have soles more than 40mm. All shoes with spikes shall not have soles more than 30 mm. The call room chief has the power to check either visually or against the WA list.

29. SEEDING FOR HEATS (RANKING)

There may be heats for running/hurdling events with several rounds from the **80m** up to and including the 1500m, and athletes will be assigned to heats according to the time provided with their entry.

For events with several rounds, the first round (Heats) will always be conducted at the scheduled

time listed in the competition schedule.. If a round needs to be cancelled because of withdrawals, the middle round (Semis) will be cancelled. Finals will always be conducted at finals time.

For longer races with direct finals, athletes will be seeded (ranked) and placed into separate sections based on their time provided with their entry. The slower section (Group B) will be conducted first. The results will consider all finals and will rank the athletes by time.

30. ADVANCEMENT PROCEDURE

Please refer to Appendix 13 for the advancement tables and special advancement tables.

31. WARM UP AREAS

31.1 Slottsskogsvallen

Participants are encouraged to warm up at the indoor hall in the House of Athletics, conveniently located near the competition arena and just a short walk from the Call Room. There are also plenty of spaces available for jogging and stretching in the vicinity of the event area.

31.2 Björlanda Athletics Center

There is a warming-up area on the competition track right next to the Call Room. Additionally, there is a gravel jogging track approximately one kilometer long that stretches around the competition venue.

31.3 Ullevi Stadium

There is a dedicated warming-up area located 100 m from the dressing rooms and the call room. The surface is asphalt.





32. TRAINING SESSIONS

All participants are welcome to train and warm up at the House of Athletics, which includes a fully equipped gym. Accreditation is required for access. Please refer to Appendix 1 for the facility layout and opening hours.

For javelin and rotating throws, there is an opportunity to train at the throwing field right next to the House of Athletics on 16 August and 21 August 21 between 10:00 and 19:00.

33. EQUIPMENT AND IMPLEMENTS

33.1 Use of Official Throwing Implements

The LOC will provide at least three (3) World Athletics implements complying with WA/WMA specifications for each throwing event. Refer to Appendix 10 for implement specifications.

33.2 Use of Official Poles

The LOC will provide a basic range of poles to be used for free by athletes competing in the Pole Vault and Decathlon events. See Appendix 11 for specifications of the poles at each competition site.

33.3 Implement control stations

At Slottsskogsvallen and at Björlanda Athletics Center, there will be Implement Control Stations. These centers will provide all necessary services related to personal equipment according to the regulations in the respective equipment sections. Our Implement Control Stations will begin to operate 12 August. Please refer to the official competition website for operating hours. The location of the Implement Control Stations are displayed on the venue layouts. General operating hours are 07:30-16:00 on competition days and 10:00-16:00 on non-competition days.

33.4 Use of Rental Poles

Pre-ordered rental poles from Nordic Sport are handled by our technical team at the Implement Control

Stations, which will begin to operate 12 August. The pole or poles you have rented will be delivered to you at the venue for your event. If you wish to practice with or prepare your pole in any way before the competition, you can check out your rental pole or poles at the Implement Control Station at Slottsskogsvallen starting from 12 August at 10:00, according to the check-in and check-out details in point 33.5.

- Rental poles for competitions at Slottsskogsvallen: Rental poles checked out for practice or preparation must be checked back in at the Implements Control Station at the venue for your event at least two (2) hours before your age group's starting time. Alternatively, you may place the pole or poles on the transport cart outside the Implements Control Station without checking them in.
- Rental poles for competitions at Björlanda
 Athletics Center: Rental poles that are checked
 out for practice or preparation must be checked
 back in at the Implement Control Station at
 Slottsskogsvallen by 12 August at 16:00 for
 transport to Björlanda Athletics Center.
 Otherwise, they will be handled as personal poles
 according to point 33.4. Please note that in
 that case, it is your responsibility to ensure your
 pole or bag of poles is at the correct venue.

33.5 Personal Poles

Personal poles are permitted for competition, provided they have passed our system for personal poles at our Implement Control Stations. There is an Implement Control Station at Slottsskogsvallen and Björlanda Athletics Center. You can use these centers for storing your poles or bag of poles by checking them in and out with the help of our staff. You can check in and out your poles or bag of poles as many times as you like, and you are free to use whichever Implement Control Station you like with no limit to how long we can store your pole or bag of poles for you. Each time you check in or out your pole or bag of poles, you will receive a receipt. The service is available between August 12 to 25.





33. EQUIPMENT AND IMPLEMENTS

Before your competition, it is your responsibility to ensure your pole or bag of poles is at the correct venue. The following applies:

- Poles or bag of poles for competitions at Slottsskogsvallen need to be checked out before your competition. There is a marked transport cart outside the Implement Control Station, labeled with your age category, where you can place your pole or bag of poles. Make sure to place your pole or bag of poles on the transport cart at least two (2) hours before your age group's staring time. They will then be transported to you at the competition site by our competition staff. You can place your pole or bag of poles on the cart without first having to check it in and out. Athletes may collect their pole or bag of poles on the marked transport cart outside the Implement Control Station at Slottsskogsvallen after the event.
- Poles or bag of poles for competitions at **Björlanda Athletics Center** must be checked in at that venue, at least two (2) hours before your age groups's start time. These poles or bag of poles should not be checked out again before the competition but will be delivered to you at the competition site. Athletes may collect their poles or bag of poles at the Implement Control Station at Björlanda Athletics Center after the event.

Please note: The organizer does not transport poles or bags of poles between different Implement Control Stations or between venues. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure their pole or bag of poles is at the correct venue. All poles or bag of poles should bear the identification of the athlete (tag of the name, country, gender, event, start number and number of poles per bag).

33.6 Personal Throwing Implements

Personal throwing implements are permitted for competition, provided they have previously been officially checked by the Judge at the Implement Control Station. Personal throwing implements shall only be issued to the specific competition of their owners. Any other competitor in the owner's

specific competition has the right to use that equipment if they so wish. Personal throwing implements will have to be submitted before the Qualification, the submission of new implements before the Finals will not be allowed.

There is an Implement Control Station at Slotts-skogsvallen and Björlanda Athetics Center, which will begin to operate 12 August at 10:00. When checking in Personal throwing implements, head to the check-in desk located at the Implement Control Station at the venue for your event. For events starting 10:00 or later, ensure that your Personal throwing implements are checked at least two (2) hours before your age group's start time at the venue for your event. If your event begins before 10:00, the check must be completed by 16:00 the day prior at the Implement Control Station at Slottsskogsvallen, regardless of the venue of your event.

Javelins may only be checked in and checked before 16:00 the previous day at the Check-in desk located at the Implement Control Station at Slottsskogsvallen, regardless of the venue for your event.

Athletes may collect their Personal throwing implements at the end of their event, including all pools and finals. Implements are collected from the Implement Control Station at the venue for your event.

33.7 Hurdles

Please refer to Appendix 12 for hurdle specifications.





34. TRACK EVENTS

34.1 Starting Blocks

Starting blocks are not mandatory, but only starting blocks provided by the LOC will be allowed.

34.2 Starter's Commands

In accordance with WA rules, the starter will give the commands in English.

For races up to and including 400m and 4x100m relays, the commands will be:

- 1. "On your marks"
- 2. "Set"
- 3. Electronic Gun / Pistol

For races from 800m, the commands will be:

- 1. "On your marks"
- 2. Electronic Gun / Pistol

34.3 False Starts

For running events, any athlete who makes a false start will be warned with a yellow/black card. Athletes who commit two false starts will be notified by a red/black card and will be eliminated from the competition. This rule also applies to Combined Events.

34.4 Composition of Finals

Please refer to the advancement tables and speciel advancement tables in Appendix 13. There may be heats for running/hurdling events with several rounds from the 80m Hurdles up to and including the 1500m, and athletes will be assigned to heats according to the time provided with their entry. For events with several rounds, the first round (Heats) will always be conducted at the scheduled time listed in the competition schedule. If a round needs to be cancelled because of withdrawals, the middle round (Semis) will be cancelled. Finals will always be conducted at finals time.

For longer races with direct finals (in age groups with many participants), athletes will be seeded (ranked) and placed into separate sections based on their time provided with their entry. Athletes with no performance time will be randomly placed in the slower sections. The slower sections (eg. Group B and Group C) will be conducted first. The results will consider all finals and will rank the athletes by time.

34.5 Special Advancement Tables

Due to the exceptionally high number of participants registered for this championship, Special Advancement Tables will be used for certain events. The affected events are:

100m: W70, M80200m: W70, M80400m: W65, M80Short Hurdles: M70

Long Hurdles: W50, M65, M701500m: All age categories

These Special Advancement Tables is shown in Appendix 13.

34.6 Timing Chips and Lap Counting

For track events including Steeplechase, 5000m and 5000m Race Walk, lap counting will be in effect at the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships. We're implementing a Radio Frequency Identification system (RFID) for participant tracking. When collecting your racing bibs for events on the track, each racer will receive a bib with a pre-programmed Ultra High Frequency tag (UHF) already attached on your front bib. Timing and lap-counting on the track will be managed using side-antennas.

A "chip-check station" will be available in the call room to verify chip usage. Lap counting will be clearly displayed for athletes on a monitor positioned close to the finish line.

Important: Please use the bib with the timing chip as your front bib.

34.7 Refreshment Tables

Refreshment tables will be provided in races 5000m and longer.





35. TRACK RELAYS

Relay Team entries must be made using the official form available from the TIC. The Team Manager must hand in the completed form to the TIC before the deadline for each relay.

- Deadline for the 4 x 100m relay entry form is due before 12:00 Friday 16 August 2024
- Deadline for the 4 x 400m relay entry form is due before 12:00 Saturday 24 August 2024

Start times for each age group will be determined after the registration deadline has passed. This information will then be published on the official LOC information board at the TIC and in the competition program on the official championship website.

Any changes to the running order, or the alternates listed on the relays form can be submitted by the Team Manager at the TIC up until two (2) hours before the event start, but no new relay teams or names will be accepted.

Eligibility for relay team participation requires that all athletes entered in the relay must also be registered for at least one individual event. However, actual competition in the registered individual event is not obligatory for relay participation. Athletes must wear their own bibs.

Only one team entry in each age group will be accepted from each country. One team member must be from the entered age group, the other team members may be in the same age group or from an older age group. An athlete can compete for only one age group in the relay.

On the form, the team manager must list the names of four (4) members of the team and, if the team wishes to use substitutes (alternates or reserves), then up to three (3) substitutes must also be listed. The names submitted on the form should show the composition of the relays and the order of running.

Any change to the final running order (using only the runners names submitted on the relay entry form) must be made at the TIC no later than two (2) hours before the event start. In case of a last-minute injury, the Call Room Referee has the authority to approve a listed substitute.

Affiliates who do not have a team manager should submit their forms directly to the TIC. Relay teams comprising members of several countries or a mixture of men and women will NOT be allowed to run.

36. FIELD EVENTS

36.1 Vertical Jumps

All vertical jump events will be direct finals. **There will be no qualifying rounds.**

For high jump and pole vault, both feet must be off the ground during the jump. Athletes are allowed to touch the landing area before clearing the bar but may not use the landing area to any advantage as determined by the field judge.

For competitions where age categories are mixed, the winner of each age group may request a special height not in usual bar heights normal progression. The other competitors will not be allowed to jump at this special height but will resume the competition at the next official height.

36.2 Starting Heights and Progression In The Competition

The starting heights and progression through the competition are detailed in Appendix 14. The competition will **NOT** start at a height:

- Lower than that indicated in appendices
- Lower than the equipment permits

36.3 Horizontal Jumps and Throws

When there are 25 or more athletes entered, the event may be divided into two groups based on their marks. Athletes with the lower marks will compete in Pool 1, while those with the best submitted marks will compete in Pool 2. If the pools are not performed in parallel, Pool 2 will compete last. After all pools are completed, the eight (8) athletes with





the best performances will have an additional three (3) attempts. The competition order for these final three (3) attempts will be in reverse ranking order based on the results after the first 3 rounds.

Which pool athletes are assigned to will be displayed the evening before in the start list in the Roster Athletics app. The starting lists are also displayed online through the official championship website. If pools are canceled after final confirmation, the direct final with all confirmed athletes will start at the scheduled start time for Pool 2.

37. COMBINED EVENTS

37.1 General Information

The following information is relevant for Decathlon, Heptathlon, and the Throws Pentathlon:

Athletes will only move from one competition area to another as instructed by the Combined Events referee. The referee will be the official source of information for the location and schedule of events. The referee will announce the results to the participants at the end of each event.

Depending on the number of declared athletes, several groups of the same age group can be formed.

The groups of a same age category will have different start times. Group A will be the athletes with the better submitted scores.

37.2 Additional Information for the Throws Pentathlon

- Athletes will be allowed three (3) attempts only
- If several pools are formed, competition will be in parallel or consecutive.
- Pool 2 will be the athletes with the best submitted marks and compete last

39. TEAM MEDALS

Team medals will be awarded for 10 000m Road Race Walk, 20 000m Road Race Walk, Cross Country and Half Marathon.

The rules for Non-Stadia Team Scoring are in the WMA Rules of Competition (Rule 151.2).

If there are three (3) or more athletes in the same age group from a country, the registration of a team is NOT required. Team awards are based on the combined times of the first three (3) athletes of that country in each age group.

To form a team where a country does not have three (3) athletes in the same age group, all of the WMA Competition rules listed in rule 151.2 must be followed, otherwise the team will be disqualified.

The Non-Stadia team registration form is available at the TIC and must be submitted to the TIC at the main stadium before 17:00 on the day before competition for Cross Country, Half Marathon, 10 000 Road Race Walk and 20 000m Road Race Walk.

40. NON-STADIA CONFIRMATION

No final confirmation is required for non-stadia events, athletes may report directly to the call room.

41. NON-STADIA CALL ROOM

Once athletes have reported to the Call Room, they will not be permitted to leave. All necessary information concerning the competition will be provided to the athletes in the Call Room. The Call Room officials will verify the accreditation, competition number, uniform, shoes and personal effects of the athletes. All athletes will be escorted from the Call Room to the competition area.

Athletes must report to the Call Room at the latest at the times shown below.

42. SECURE BAG-DROP

At all non-stadia events, a secure bag drop facility will be available for athletes. Athletes are advised to bring personal bags clearly labeled with their name and bib number, or to use the bag tag provided in the athletes' registration pack. These bags will be stored in a secure location throughout the duration of the event.

43. SOLES

All shoes in any event shall not have soles more than 40mm. The call room chief has the power to check either visually or against the WA list.

44. WARM UP AREA

There are warm-up areas available at the start of all non-stadia events.

45. TOILETS

Additional toilet facilities will be provided in the starting and finishing areas of all non-stadia events.

46. MEDICAL SERVICE

Medical staff will be located around the course and close to the finish line.

47. STARTER'S COMMANDS

In accordance with WA rules, the starter will give the commands in English.

- 1. "On your marks"
- 2. Electronic Gun / Pistol

IMPORTANT REMINDER Participating athletes must not be accompanied by persons on bike, running or by other means of transport.

48. TIMING CHIPS AND LAP COUNTING

At the 2024 World Masters Athletics Championships, we're utilizing a Radio Frequency Identification system (RFID) for participant tracking. When collecting your racing bibs for non-stadia events, each racer will receive a bib with a pre-programmed Ultra High Frequency tag (UHF) already attached on your front bib. Timing for non-stadia events will be managed using mats and side-antennas. Lap counting will be clearly displayed for athletes on a monitor positioned close to the finish line.

A "chip-check station" will be available in the call room to verify chip usage. Lap counting will be clearly displayed for athletes on a monitor positioned close to the finish line.

Important: Please use the bib with the timing chip as your front bib.





ROAD RACE WALK

49. ROAD RACE WALK RACECOURSE

Please see Appendix 15 for the competition course for all Road Race Walk events.

50. JUDGES

Road Race-walking will be judged by a team of international race-walking judges (IRWJ). Athletes can be disqualified during or after the race.

51. ROAD RACE WALK REFRESHMENTS

A Refreshment post will be provided at every lap as stated in the rules of World Athletics and WMA.

The athletes are allowed to have their own refreshments. They must be clearly marked with the bib number and will be available on the table for personal refreshments. Athletes are required to give their personal refreshments to the staff at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the race. For this they must bring the drinks to the tables provided for this purpose in the designated area. A maximum of two officials per country may be stationed behind the drinks table to manage the personal refreshments of the athletes competing. No refreshments to be issued outside the refreshment zone.

Country representatives must not in any way interfere with the progress of the race. An athlete who receives or collects refreshment or water from a place other than the official stations or takes the refreshment of another athlete, should, for a first such offence, be warned by the Referee normally by showing a yellow card. For a second offence, the Referee shall disqualify the athlete, normally by showing a red card.

52. ROAD RACE WALK AWARDS

52.1 Road Race Walk 10K

Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals in each age category, men and women, at the medal presentation area in the Athletes' Village. There will also be team medals awarded for this event. The team registration form must be submitted to the TIC at the main stadium before 17:00 on Friday 16 August.

52.2 Road Race Walk 20K

Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals in each age category, men and women, at the medal presentation area in the Athletes' Village. There will also be team medals awarded for this event. The team registration form must be submitted to the TIC at the main stadium before 17:00 on Saturday 24 August.

54. ROAD RUN AND HALF MARATHON REFRESHMENTS

A Refreshment post will be provided at every lap as stated in the rules of World Athletics and WMA.

In the Half Marathon event, athletes are allowed to have their own refreshments. They must be clearly marked with the bib number and will be available on the table for personal refreshments. Athletes are required to give their personal refreshments to the staff at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the race. For this they must bring the drinks to the tables provided for this purpose in the designated area. A maximum of two officials per country may be stationed behind the drinks table to manage the personal refreshments of the athletes competing. No refreshments to be issued outside the refreshment zone.

Country representatives must not in any way interfere with the progress of the race. An athlete who receives or collects refreshment or water from a place other than the official stations or takes the refreshment of another athlete, should, for a first such offence, be warned by the Referee normally by showing a yellow card. For a second offence, the Referee shall disqualify the athlete, normally by showing a red card.

55. ROAD RUN AND HALF MARATHON AWARDS

55.1 Road Run 10K

Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals in each age category, men and women, at the medal presentation area in the Athletes' Village. There are no team medals awarded for this event.

55.2 Half Marathon

Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals in each age category, men and women, at the medal presentation area in the Athlete's Village. See Appendix 7 for medal ceremony schedule. There will also be team medals awarded for this event. The team registration form must be submitted to the TIC at the main stadium before 17:00 on Friday 23 August.





CROSS COUNTRY

56. CROSS COUNTRY CATEGORIES

Cross Country races will be conducted in the following categories:

- Male and Female age groups 70 and over: 6km
- Male and Female age groups 35-65: 8 km

57. CROSS COUNTRY RACECOURSE

Please see Appendix 17 for the competition course for the Cross Country.

58. CROSS COUNTRY REFRESHMENTS

A Refreshment post will be provided at every lap as stated in the rules of World Athletics and WMA. No personal drinks will be allowed.

59. PACING

No pacing will be permitted. It is a disqualification offence.

60. CROSS COUNTRY AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals in each age category, men and women, at the medal presentation area in the Athlete's Village. There will also be team medals awarded for this event. The team registration form must be submitted to the TIC at the main stadium before 17:00 on Monday 19 August.








APPENDIX 1 STADIUM LAYOUT HOUSE OF ATHLETICS





3. Wait for Verification:

Allow up to 48 hours for the verification process.

4. Check Athlete Verification:

Once the athlete(s) appear under the "ATHLETE CHECK-IN" menu in the Roster Athletics app, the verification process is complete.

If you already have a Roster account, go to the web registration portal at **meets.rosterathletics.com** and log in to your account. In the next step, you must add the **First name**, **Last name**, **Date of birth** and select the applicable **Gender**, **Country**, and **Club/school** (all these fields are mandatory).

Please note: If your entry has already been added by another account (e.g., a coach, federation, etc.), the athlete profile you've just created will be verified and matched with the existing athlete on the start list. The verification process is handled by Roster Athletics and may take up to 48 hours.












APPENDIX 17 HALF MARATHON 21K COMPETITION COURSE




