The competition is a qualification opportunities for Olympic Games Tokyo 2020.

The 47th International Race Walking Festival - Alytus'2021 will take place on Friday, **11 June** in Alytus City

Alytus is the centre of the culture, sport and industry of the South Lithuania. The distance between Alytus and Vilnius (capital of Lithuania) is 100 km, the distance between Alytus and Kaunas is 75 km, between Alytus and Hrodna (BLR) and between Alytus and Augustow (POL) - 100 km.

Alytus has received the city rights based on the Magdeburg Law in 1581.

The population of Alytus is approximately 51,000 people..

XIII. Safety and Security

The competition is conducted in accordance with World Athletics (WA) regulations.

R.Jurgelevičius, technical director of the competition is responsible for the participants and spectators.

XIV. Covid-19 health and safety rules

All competitors (including their accompanying persons) arriving from abroad must be able to present a negative RT-PCR test result or antigen test for COVID 19 not older than 72 hours at the time of their arrival to the Lithuania.

Passengers FROM ALL THE COUNTRIES (listed or not listed as affected) travelling on international routes organised and operated by carriers as regular, special and charter services by all modes of transport must complete a questionnaire and present the confirmation of the completed electronic form (QR code) to the carrier before boarding a vehicle. - Those arriving in Lithuania from ALL COUNTRIES by their own transport until the moment of crossing the border of the Republic of Lithuania must fill in the QUESTIONNAIRE and provide confirmation of the completed electronic questionnaire (QR code) to NVSC specialists or other officials at the border checkpoint or passenger checkpoint. Each competitor(including their accompanying persons) must present their valid negative test during the accreditation process.

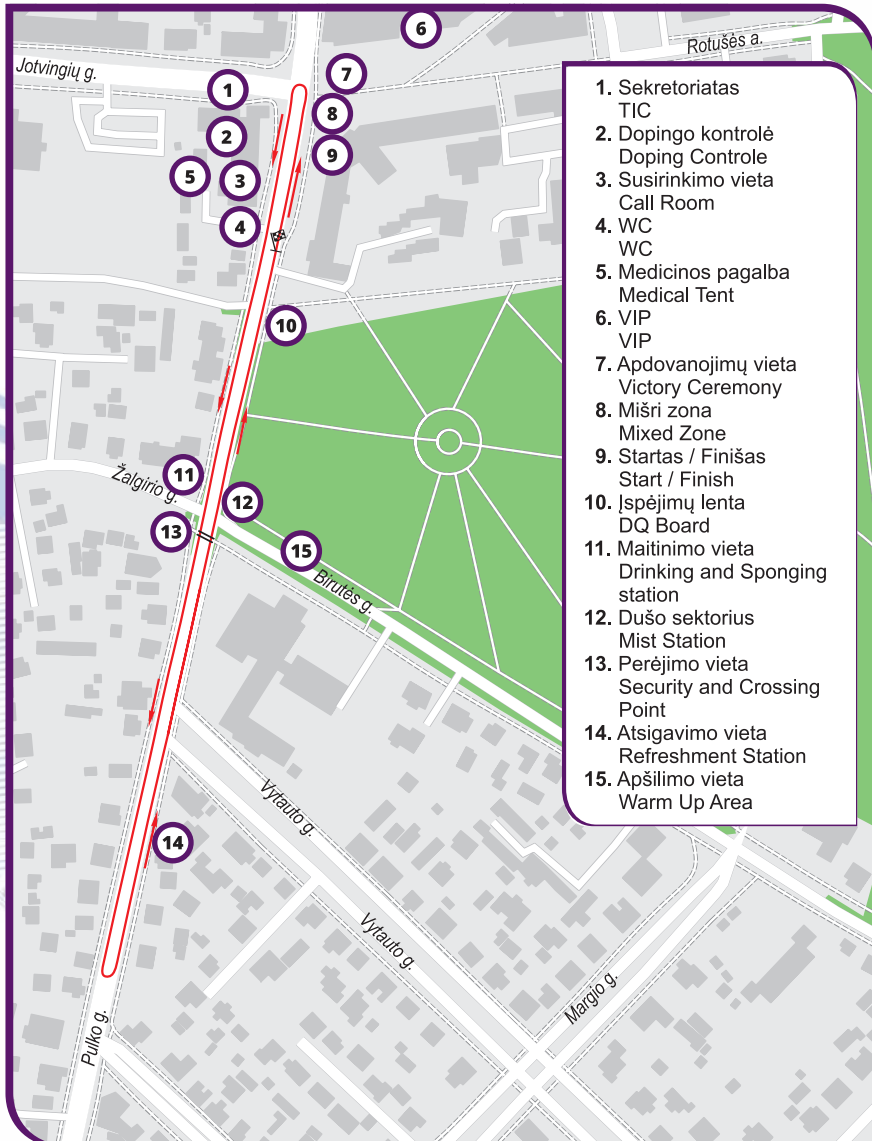
After accreditation, each competitor, any accompanying persons of the team will have to undertake antigen test for Covid 19 in accordance with the regulation of the Public Health Authority of the Lithuanian Republic. **The testing expenses on the LOC responsibility.**

Athletes will go to the start line with a face mask or other appropriate face covering. After crossing the start line, they can take the covering off and continue competition without it. Every competitor will receive a face mask from the organizer after crossing finish line and they will be asked to leave the finish area immediately.

Entry into the enclosed competition areas will be allowed only with a mask or other face covering (buff, scarf) and after using hand sanitizer.
